Calona Vineyards *Artist Series* tells a story that begins on the label and finishes on your palate. It's about award-winning wines and wonderful art brought together to reflect each other's brilliance. Each painting is carefully selected for the special way it evokes the unique flavour of the wine. **Ken Kirkby's "An Arctic Dream", a stoic Inukshuk beneath a glowing sky, speaks to the boldness and depth of our Syrah.** It's an exhibition of individual taste and a showcase for the wines of Calona Vineyards.

SYRAH 2001 - New Varietal!
Beautiful, complex aromas of blueberry, raspberry, dark toast and spice make this a very interesting Syrah. Colour and tannins are on the lighter side, but are balanced with lovely fruit flavours which make this a tasty sipper.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Syrah is one of the newest and most interesting varietals in the Okanagan. The grape requires a lot of heat to ripen fully, and is thought of as a "big" wine. This Syrah was allowed to ripen until the very end of the 2001 vintage. Careful, thoughtful handling of the fruit at crush and ageing in French oak barrels has given us this delightful wine.
