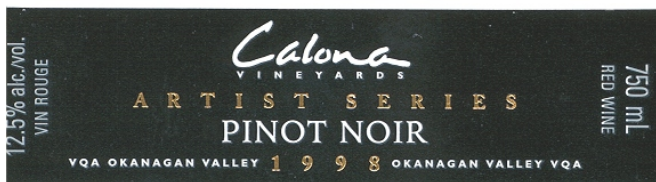

PINOT NOIR 1998

Careful attention in the vineyard and gentle fruit handling make our 1998 Pinot Noir a subtle and appealing wine, deep ruby in colour. It is bursting with cherry, jam and black pepper flavours and shows ripe tannins that make it rewarding to drink now and in the next few years.

WINE MAKER NOTES

Pinot Noir is a particularly old vine variety distinctly reflecting the characteristics of the site on which it is planted. As a result, the only characteristics that the Pinot Noirs of the world share is a sweet fruitiness and lower levels of tannins and pigments. Demanding much of the grower and the wine maker, this grape variety lures the most ambitious to develop their own distinctive Pinot Noir. This vintage of Pinot Noir is a true reflection of the unique, top quality growing conditions of British Columbia.

FOOD SUGGESTIONS

Pairs wonderfully with pork roast in a cherry sauce, a variety of soft and hard cheeses, as well as roast leg of lamb.
