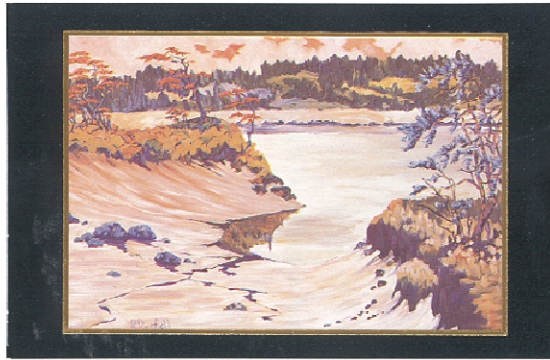

PINOT BLANC 1998

This attractive Pinot Blanc displays flavours of rich, fully ripened fruit, apple, pear and vanilla spice. Generous and refreshing, this intense 1998 vintage shows remarkable strength in character and offers a firm, crisp finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Pinot Blanc derives its origins from the Burgundy region of France as a variant or mutation of Pinot Gris, which itself is a lighter-coloured version of Pinot Noir. A Gold Medal Winner at the 1999 International Judging at the Okanagan Wine Festival, grapes for our 1998 Pinot Blanc come from vineyards in the south Okanagan Valley, where the hot sun and deep sand allow excellent ripening. 40% oak aging adds complexity to this dry white wine.
