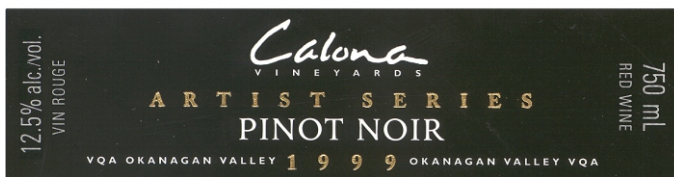

PINOT NOIR 1999

This wine offers the classic aromas, tastes and structure of a good Pinot Noir. Bursting with fruit flavours of dark sweet cherries with a hint of fresh, ripe strawberry, it is medium bodied and long on the palate with a soft, silky mouthfeel.

WINE MAKER NOTES

Pinot Noir is a particularly old vine variety distinctly reflecting the characteristics of the site on which it is planted. Demanding much of the grower and the wine maker, this grape variety lures the most ambitious to develop their own distinctive Pinot Noir. This vintage of Pinot Noir is a true reflection of the unique, top quality growing conditions of British Columbia.

The cool ripening conditions of the fall of 1999 allowed these grapes to linger on the vine for an extra ten days, allowing more complete fruit development. Used French oak was employed for barrel ageing to add structure to the wine without the oak flavours dominating the fruit aspects.
